

BUMPER SWAP COMPACTS

READ and REREAD ALL RULES, don't twist or bend these rules. <u>"IF IT DOESN'T SAY YOU CAN, DON'T DO IT." Ask first or don't do it.</u> <u>All Inspector's decisions are final!</u> Use common sense! Must be four or six cylinder compact car. Compact cars will consist of rear-wheel-drive cars of 106" factory well base or smaller and any front-wheel-drive car EXCEPT for 1985 and older Eldorado, Tornado and Riviera's.

Bumper swap youth compacts must be between the ages of 10-16 years of age.

YOUTH CLASS MUST HAVE PASSENGER AND BE OVER THE AGE OF 18 FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Cars will receive TWO attempts to pass inspection.
- ❖ The vehicle must be completely stripped before entering the pits. No glass, windshield or other debris permitted.
- ❖ ALL airbags and airbag assemblies must be COMPLETELY removed from vehicle.
- ❖ Hoods must be <u>OPEN</u> for inspection.

FIX PLATES

- ❖ 4-4x4-1/2" fix plates only on fresh and pre ran vehicle.
 - NO moving of plates once they are on the vehicle.
 - **NO** plates from sub to frame.
 - Plates must be <u>2"</u> apart and at least <u>2"</u> from you 3x6 bumper plate.
 - Plates can be welded solid with no more the ½" weld around them.

DRIVETRAIN

- Must be factory drivetrain for the specific make & model.
 - Harnesses are allowed.
 - Carb conversions are allowed.
 - Aftermarket shifters, headers and tranny coolers are allowed.
 - Top motor mount can be solid.
 - Lower motor mounts must remain stock to that specific car.
 - Steering columns and pedals are permitted.

TIRE & WHEEL

- The vehicle can utilize any tire.
 - NO bead protectors.
 - Must be stock OEM rim.
 - Small weld in centers is permitted.
 - Forklift tires are allowed on the rear only.
 - <u>2"</u> lip protectors are allowed, no more then <u>2"</u> front wheel lip towards the center.

BODY

- ❖ DOORS-Choose between 2-3x3 plates per vertical seem on doors or #9 wire, no more than two strands or bands.
 - Will allow <u>ONE</u> spot around each door post of #9 wire if you choose.

- Driver's door maybe be welded solid or have door skin protector. Door skin must not go any further then <u>3"</u> past door seems on driver door.
- <u>YOUTH VEHICLES CAN HAVE PASSENGER DOOR SAME AS DRIVERS</u> DOOR. YOUTH CLASS ONLY.

♦ HOOD & TRUNK

- Hood banded or #9 wire <u>two</u> strands per spot in <u>six places</u>, <u>two</u> of which may go around the frame\sub.
- Must be 12" inspection hole in hood, this will be enforced.
- May use **6-3/8 bolts per hole** in the hood to re-bolt sheet metal.
- NO washers welded to anything to run band or #9 wire.
- Trunk deck lid on sedans or wagons may be tucked in <u>90 degrees</u>, but must remain on its factory hinges in the factory location, without manipulation.
- Trunk and speaker deck are considered one and cannot be dished or manipulated.
- Must have 12" inspection hole in trunk, this will be enforced.
- Trunk can be banded or wired with #9 wire no more than <u>two</u> strands per hole in <u>six</u> spots, <u>two</u> of which may go around frame.
- You may crease rear quarter panels only.

❖ SUSPENSION

- Suspension must stay stock
- Front suspension must bounce, this will be enforced.
- NO altering of suspension.
- The only modification you can do is add spring spacers or strut risers to gain appropriate height.
- Rear only can be welded with a nut or washer to strut shaft to obtain height.

❖ BATTERY

- Battery must be removed from stock location and secured to the passenger floorboard, using battery box or tray.
- YOUTH CLASS, MUST BE BETWEEN THE DASH BAR & FIREWALL OR MOUNTED BEHIND THE SEATS.

♦ CAGE

- 4-point cage is recommended.
- You must have at least one bar behind the seat.
- NO down bars.
- Side bars must not go back past driver's seat more then <u>6"</u> or no further back the rear kick panel.

- 2x6 inch tubing max on cage. NO BIGGER.
- Rollover bars are allowed but cannot be more than <u>4"</u> past B-pillar, must go straight across and must attach to rear seat bar only.
- Front window bar is allowed. It can attach to front of the rollover bar and attach to the dash bar or the top of the firewall.
- The gas tank must be behind the seats
 - NO plastic tank allowed\stock tank must be removed.
 - Gas tank protector is allowed to be tight to packing tray.
 - ♦ Gas tank protector must not exceed 32" wide (outside to outside) and no taller than speaker deck in factory location.
 - ◆ TWO GTP GUSSETS MAX. You choose one per side, GTP to seat bar or GTP to halo\rollover bar. One or the other. All gussets and cage must remain 6" from the rear strut towers.

❖ BUMPERS

- Instead of OEM bumper you may run 4"x4"-1/4" square wall tubing for front bumper.
 - ◆ You may put a point on front bumper, but it must exceed 30" span across and no more then 8" from the center point to backside of bumper where it's mounted.
 - ◆ The length of the bumper <u>cannot</u> go beyond the outside of the fenders.
 - ♦ Bumper maybe hardnosed
 - ◆ 2-3x6-1/4" plates on the outside of the frame/unibody to mount bumper.
 - ◆ Core support must stay in the factory location. <u>"CALL ON HONDA'S"</u>
 - ♦ Any ¼" thick replica bumpers are allowed as long as it fits in the dimensions above. <u>"NO CHRYSLER POINTY REPLICAS"</u>
- No welding on the car except for what is stated above.
- This is a fun and easy stock build
- Must have a roof sign with number
